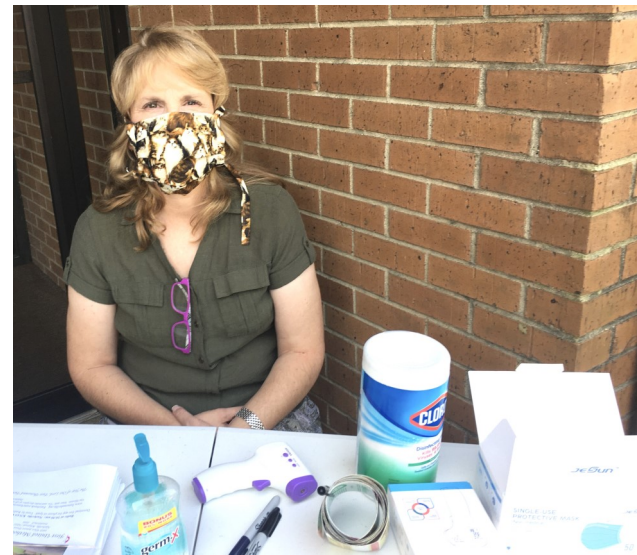

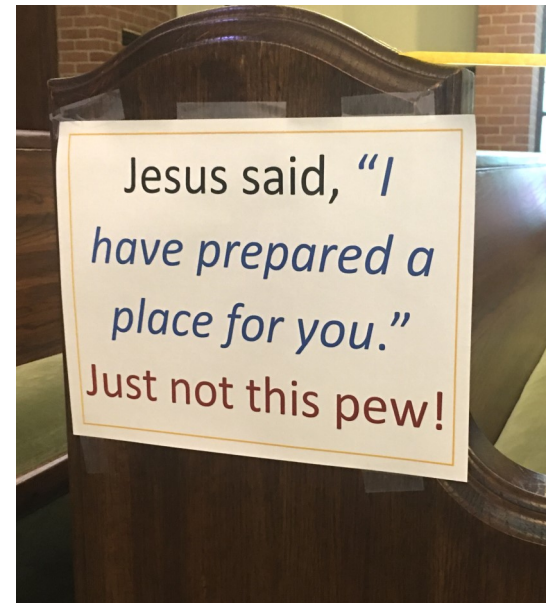

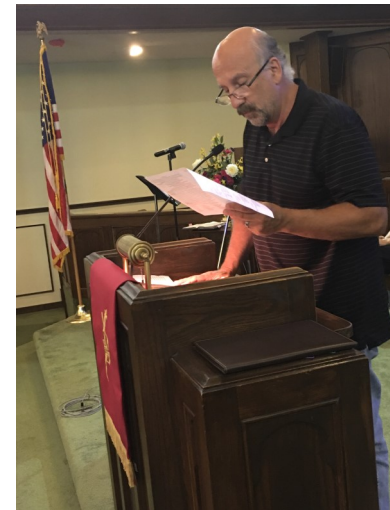

She has agreed to come to an in-Person Charge Conference in our Fellowship Hall. Persons are still welcome to join the meeting virtually by Zoom in the safety of their homes.
